Amory Street is a welcoming, caring community that embraces people from all walks of life. We offer a wide variety of living arrangements for low-and-moderate income elderly and disabled persons.

This six-story, elevator-equipped building has approximately 184 units in studio, one-bedroom or two-bedroom apartments. Many of our units are equipped with special amenities specifically designed for elderly and disabled individuals, such as emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathroom, and intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

We are located at 125 Amory Street on the Jamaica Plain/Roxbury border.

The surrounding neighborhood is very pleasant and inviting, with several parks along Amory Street. Our complex is only a few blocks from the Stony Brook MBTA station in Jamaica Plain. We are conveniently located near Egleston and Jackson Squares where you can find many stores and services including banks, Stop & Shop, ethnic food restaurants, CVS, Walgreen's, a fish market, gas station, barber shop, a public library, the E-13 police station, Dimock Street Community Health Center, Martha Elliot Health Center and Brookside Neighborhood Health Center.
