Built in 1962, our sunlit apartments have nice hardwood floors and ceramic tiled bathrooms.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

Annapolis is located in Dorchester near Columbia Road, with many stores, businesses and restaurants conveniently located nearby at Uphams Corner or South Bay Shopping Center. Health care is available at the Uphams Corner Health Center.
