Eva White is a warm, welcoming community that offers a variety of living arrangements for low- and moderate-income elderly and disabled persons. Eva White offers approximately 102 efficiency, one- and two-bedroom apartments in two seven-story, elevated-equipped buildings. Our complex is located in the vibrant South End community of Boston.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

Eva White is located within the Castle Square Development in the South End. A variety of businesses and services are located nearby or within a quick ride on public transportation. Chinatown and downtown Boston are only a ten-minute walk. There are several churches in the area as well.

Health care is nearby, with South Cove Community Health Center and New England Medical Center a short distance away.

PROGRAMS & AMENITIES

We offer a wide range of amenities, programs, and services to help you feel at home. These include:

- Security guard on-site seven days a week
- 24-hour phone coverage in the event of an emergency
- Floor captains to help with any emergency
- Community room with laundry facilities
- Courtyard patio with benches
- Professionally managed by Winn Management Company for the Boston Housing Authority
- Resident coffee hour
- Activity club that regularly plays Mahjong
- Health screenings
