Welcome to General Warren Apartments. We are pleased that you are considering our community for your future home.

General Warren is a warm, welcoming community that offers a variety of living arrangements for low- and moderate-income elderly and disabled persons. General Warren offers approximately 96 one- and two-bedroom apartments in garden-style buildings located in two areas, about a one-quarter of a mile apart. Built in 1971, the apartments were recently renovated.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

General Warren is located on Washington Street in Charlestown. A variety of shops and businesses are located nearby. There are many churches in the area as well.

Health care is available nearby at the Bunker Hill Community Health Center.

PROGRAMS & AMENITIES

We offer a wide range of amenities, programs, and services to help you feel at home. These include:

- Off-street parking in several resident lots
- Spacious, sunny apartments with large, eat-in kitchens
- Laundry facilities in the two community rooms
- Sliding glass doors that open to balconies in several units
- Individual furnaces and thermostats
- The Golden Age Center is located in one of the community room which provides staff and programming for events such as bingo, ceramics and trips
- Professionally managed by Winn Management Company for the Boston Housing Authority
- Resident office hour
- Health screenings
