We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

Hassan is located in Mattapan, within walking distance to Mattapan Square and the many shops and businesses located there. There are many churches of different denominations in the area as well. Health care is available at River Street Health Center and Mattapan Community Health Center.
