Meade offers approximately 39 one-bedroom apartments in a garden-style setting. Our two-story complex is named in memory of a former Boston Housing Authority manager who had strong ties to the community. We think that you will enjoy this quiet, pleasant community.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

J.J. Meade is located in Dorchester, just outside Codman Square, home to many stores and services. There are many churches in the area as well. Health care is available at Codman Square Community Health Center.
