

## RESIDENT SERVICE COORDINATORS

The BHA's Elderly and Disabled Resident Service Coordinators have been trained to:

- perform need assessments and make appropriate referrals for services
- access services to enhance tenancy and independent life
- coordinate services for home bound frail elderly/disabled
- help residents to access services that enhance quality of life
- assist in crisis intervention with tenants at risk
- advocate and liaison with management, family, health providers and community agencies.

## TRANSPORTATION

Public transportation via bus service is a two-minute walk from the complex. MBTA buses provide transportation to the Ruggles Street Station on the Orange Line and Ashmont Station on the Red Line.

THE RIDE, a door-to-door transportation service provided by the MBTA, is available by appointment for persons with disabilities.

Also, a city-operated Senior Shuttle is available by appointment for residents to go to doctor's appointments and grocery shopping.
