Martin Luther King Towers is a warm, welcoming community that offers a variety of living arrangements for low- and moderate-income elderly and disabled persons. Martin Luther King Towers offers approximately 102 studio and one-bedroom apartments in a high-rise, fourteen-story building. Built in the 1960s, Martin Luther King Towers commands sweeping views of Boston Harbor, downtown Boston and scenic Blue Hills.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

Martin Luther King Towers is located in Roxbury in a vibrant neighborhood with many shops, restaurants and services. The Tower is right next door to Washington Park Mall, which includes a supermarket, dry cleaners and numerous local merchant shops. Walgreen's is a five-minute walk away. Also nearby are Malcolm X Park, the Shelburne Community Center, an MDC pool and basketball courts.
