Welcome to Walnut Park Apartments. We are pleased that you are considering our community for your future home.

Walnut Park is a warm, welcoming community that offers a variety of living arrangements for low- and moderate-income elderly and disabled persons. Our development offers approximately 168 studio, one- and two-bedroom apartments in a unique, round-shaped twenty-story, elevator-equipped building built in the 1970s.

Many of our units are equipped with special amenities specifically designed for elderly and disabled individuals, such as emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathroom, and intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests.

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

Walnut Park is located in the heart of Egleston Square in Roxbury. Our complex is close to a wide variety of stores and services in the surrounding community.

In Egleston Square, you will find a number of banks, a Stop & Shop, ethnic food restaurants, CVS, Walgreen's, a fish market, gas station, barber shop, a public library, the E-13 police station, Dimock Street Community Health Center, Martha Elliot Health Center and Brookside Neighborhood Health Center.
