West Ninth Street offers approximately 84 one- and two-bedroom apartments in a garden-style environment. Our complex is located in South Boston, near community beaches.

We offer many amenities for elderly and disabled individuals, which include emergency pull cords in the bedrooms and bathrooms as well as intercoms in every apartment. We have units that are handicap accessible and we may modify existing apartments based on Reasonable Accommodation requests

Residents pay 30 percent of their income towards rent, prorated rent, or a predetermined flat rent.

LOCATION

West Ninth Street is located in South Boston near Columbia Park. Public transportation is available nearby to transport residents to the many shops, restaurants and services along Broadway Street in South Boston and to downtown Boston.

There are a number of churches in the surrounding community. Health care is available at the South Boston Community Health Center and New England Medical Center is a short car/bus ride away.
