

RESIDENT SERVICE COORDINATORS

The BHA's Elderly and Disabled Resident Service Coordinators have been trained to:

- perform need assessments and make appropriate referrals for services
- access services to enhance tenancy and independent life
- coordinate services for home bound frail elderly/disabled
- help residents to access services that enhance quality of life
- assist in crisis intervention with tenants at risk
- advocate and act as liaison with management, family, health providers, and community agencies.

TRANSPORTATION

Public transportation via bus service is available three blocks away from Monsignor Powers. Buses provide transportation to Broadway and Andrew Square stations on the MBTA Red Line and to downtown Boston via New England Medical Center.
