



Boston Housing Authority Scholarship Program Information

Academic Year 2022–2023

Are you interested in attending Northeastern University?

If you are a graduating high school senior or transfer student currently living in BHA public housing, you are eligible for a full tuition scholarship.

To apply, you must submit:

- > The Common Application, which can be found at commonapp.org, or the Coalition Application, available at mycoalition.org/public/info/northeastern.
- > Supporting documents, including transcripts and letters of recommendation. Please refer to northeastern.edu/admissions/application-information for specific requirements.
- > A verification letter from Sahar Lawrence, Resident Capacity Program Manager at the BHA.*

The application and all supporting documents must be received in order for Northeastern to make an admission decision. If English is your second language, you may also be required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam, the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam, or the Pearson's Test of English (PTE).

*Candidates must submit a letter verifying their residence in BHA public housing within one month of submitting their admission application.

The application deadlines are as follows:

- > **Early Decision I:** November 1 (decisions released by December 15)
- > **Early Action:** November 1 (decisions released by February 1)
- > **Early Decision II:** January 1 (decisions released by February 15)
- > **Regular Decision:** January 1 (decisions released by April 1)
- > **Fall Transfer:** April 1 (decisions released by June 15)
- > **Spring Transfer:** October 1 (decisions released by December 1)

Interested students should file their FAFSA and CSS Profile by the priority filing deadline listed below.

- > For the FAFSA, visit fafsa.ed.gov and use Northeastern University code 002199.
- > For the CSS Profile, visit cssprofile.collegeboard.org and use Northeastern University code 3667.

Early Decision I: November 15 | **Early Action:** December 1 | **Early Decision II:** January 15 |
Regular Decision: February 15 | **Fall Transfer:** April 15 | **Spring Transfer:** October 15

¿Estás interesado en asistir a la Universidad de Northeastern?

Si estás a punto de graduarte de high school o eres un estudiante de transferencia y actualmente resides en vivienda pública de la BHA, tienes derecho a una beca por el valor de la matrícula completa.

Para solicitar la beca debes enviar:

- El formulario del Common Application que se encuentra en commonapp.org.
 - Documentos adicionales, incluyendo reportes académicos y cartas de recomendación; por favor, consulta los requisitos específicos en northeastern.edu/admissions/application-information.
 - Una carta de verificación emitida por Sahar Lawrence, la directora de servicios comunitarios de la BHA.*
- Para poder tomar una decisión sobre tu solicitud de admisión, Northeastern debe haber recibido tu formulario y todos los documentos adicionales.

Si inglés es tu segunda lengua, puede que tengas que tomar una prueba de tu dominio del idioma, ya sea el examen TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), el examen IELTS (International English Language Testing System) o el examen PTE (Pearson's Test of English).

*Tras enviar la solicitud de admisión, todo candidato debe presentar en un mes, a más tardar, una carta verificando su residencia en vivienda pública de la BHA.

Las fechas límite para enviar tu solicitud son las siguientes:

- Decisión temprana I: 1º de noviembre (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 15 de diciembre)
- Acción temprana: 1º de noviembre (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 1º de febrero)
- Decisión temprana II: 1º de enero (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 15 de febrero)
- Decisión regular: 1º de enero (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 1º de abril)
- Transferencia en otoño: 1º de abril (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 15 de junio)
- Transferencia en primavera: 1º de octubre (Las decisiones se anuncian antes del 1º de diciembre)

Los estudiantes interesados deben enviar su FAFSA y su CSS Profile antes de la fecha límite para solicitudes con prioridad que aparece en cada sitio web.
